

Here you will find the most recent **Campus Crime Statistics** compiled by PC ProSchools in compliance with the certification requirements of the Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act of 1989, 20 USC 3171 et seq, and Title XII of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (20 USC 1001 et seq) as amended (the Campus Crime and Security Act / Jeanne Clery Act).

Additionally, the federal Campus Sex Crimes Prevention Act, enacted on October 28, 2000, went into effect October 28, 2002. The law requires institutions of higher education to issue a statement advising the campus community where information provided by the State concerning registered sex offenders may be obtained. Please contact the Sexual Offender Registry Board. It also requires sex offenders already required to register in a state to provide notice, as required under state law, to each institution of higher education in that state at which the person is employed, carries on a vocation, or is a student.
